Water polo is a sport which started in Scotland at the end of the nineteenth century. William Wilson, a man who was **(9)** _____ on competitive swimming, created a team game that could be played with a ball in water. He wrote down some clear **(10)** _____ and called it aquatic football, although at the time other people compared it with other sports. Some described it as **(11)** _____ to rugby but played in water. The first public game was played in the River Dee in Scotland and it became popular after that, perhaps because people didn't need much **(12)** _____ to play it.

In 1885 The Swimming Association of Great Britain **(13)** _____ on calling it water polo. People began playing it in Europe, the USA and Australia, and men's water polo was one of the first team sports introduced in the Olympic Games in 1900.
